2. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show, the Caves Farm, its directors and employees, and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise.
3. The management reserves the right to interpret all questions regarding the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final.
4. In the event of cancellation of classes due to severe weather or other emergency, refund of all entry fees will be made to exhibitors.
5. Entries must be received by **February 23, 2010** to be considered timely.
6. Please mail your pre-entry as soon as possible. There is no fee to scratch. Post entries will be charged \$15.00 additional. Please, no phone entries.
7. All exhibitors must wear protective headgear at all times when mounted on the show grounds.
8. Prize money will be applied to your bill. Any prize money not applied to the bill, or over the amount of the bill, will be payable to the owner, unless otherwise stated. Please allow one-half hour for processing.
9. All Pony and Junior Hunters must show a current measurement card. All Amateur riders must present their cards before numbers may be picked up.

10. The official veterinarian will be available to conduct measurements as follows:  
Saturday, February 27, 2010 - 10:00 a.m. - 10:30 a.m.  
Sunday, February 28, 2010 - 10:00 a.m. - 10:30 a.m.  
If the veterinarian is required to measure at any time other than as stated above, the owner is responsible for paying veterinarian fees.
11. The State of Maryland requires the show to possess a copy of a negative Coggins Certificate from every horse on the show grounds. The Coggins Certificate must be presented at the horse show office before numbers can be picked up.
12. Entry forms must be filled out completely, including all classes or divisions entered, signatures, ID numbers, and organization or membership numbers before numbers can be issued. Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and those of their agents in preparation of their entry form. **An Open Check is required before numbers can be picked up.**
13. Poling and/or the use of bamboo pole offsets are prohibited. Any rider or trainer found poling or using offsets and/or who, on the opinion of the judges or committee, uses their whip or spurs in an excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred, be suspended from further showing for a 24 hours period, and will forfeit entries for that class.
14. SCHOOLING: Schooling over fences will be allowed until 7:30 a.m.
15. Limited number of permanent stalls with doors may be available. Call Caves Farm for information.
16. SCRATCHES: Please take care of “Class Adds” and “Class Scratches” at least one hour before the start of the division. A form will be available at the Horse Show Office.
17. A processing fee of \$50.00 plus collection fees will be charged for all nonnegotiable checks.
18. All hunter classes will be judged on performance, manners, soundness and way of going. A dotted line may be used in all classes.
19. An office fee of \$20.00 will be assessed all entries.

33. Gittings Horsemanship ..... Entry Fee: \$25.00  
Open to Junior riders. The class shall be judged on performance of rider over eight or more jumps with wings, not over 3', on seat and hands; guidance and control of the mount throughout the whole course. The course must contain an oxer and at least one change of direction, and two of the following which may not be combined: a bending line, a narrow jump (6'-8'), a roll back turn, a fence at the end of the ring or a long approach to a single fence. Jumping faults shall not be counted. Judges may request any or all riders to make a second ride over the complete course on any designated mount. Test No. 16 is the only additional test that may be used. To fill a class, six entries must complete the course.
51. MHSA Children's Pony Medal ..... Entry Fee: \$25.00  
Open to Junior riders on a pony and jump eight fences of hunter type with or without wings. The course must contain an oxer, at least one change of direction, and two of the following which may not be combined: a bending line, a narrow jump (6'-8'), a roll back turn, a fence at the end of the ring, or a long approach to a single fence. No in and out can be used. Small/Medium ponies to jump 2', and Large Ponies to jump 2'6". Class to be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control throughout. To fill a class, 4 must complete the course. Only one rider per pony. The MHSA Children's Pony Medal class may be run concurrently with the MHSA Children's Pony Hunter division.
60. MHSA Hunter Seat on Ponies ..... Entry Fee: \$25.00  
Open to Junior riders on a pony and jump 8 or more fences of hunter type with or without wings. The course must contain an oxer, at least one change of direction and two of the following which may not be combined: a bending line, a narrow jump (6'-8'), a roll back turn, a fence at the end of the ring or a long approach to a single fence. Small ponies to jump 2'3"; medium ponies to jump 2'6"; and large ponies to jump 3'.
